Charlie Roe (No 82) has donated the harmonium that came out of the 'chapel' at Batchmere, played while tenants sang 'God Save the King' during World War II, and a rocking horse he made for his children.

The Booths (No 15) unearthed a couple of LSA cardboard boxes. They were called 'filmers', although the word itself does not exist in the dictionary! Becky Wilson (No 45) suggests 'fill em up' or how about 'fill me' – The actual answer or other options as to the origin of the word would be gratefully received?
